As law enforcement leaders in Clark County we are committed to the precept that the criminal justice system must be free of bias, provide equal protections for all, and serve to protect the most vulnerable members of our community.

We reject hate, bigotry, harassment, violence or the inciting of violence, and all actions intended to harm or intimidate others based on race, ethnicity, religion, sexual orientation, gender identity, immigration status, or any other attribute which serves to marginalize people or groups of people.

We are committed to ensuring that our respective criminal justice agencies maintain, both in policy and in practice, an unflinching standard of conduct in which we, as criminal justice professionals, enforce the law and maintain the public peace in an unbiased manner.

Finally, we are fully committed to the investigation and prosecution of all crimes based on hate or bigotry against any member of our community.
